


# FAMILY GUIDE

*Have some family fun this week!*

Provide foil for kids to construct their own boats. Discuss what features might help a boat float. Allow kids to predict whether a boat will float, and then test each boat in the shallow water.

**SAY:** Imagine making a boat that would actually hold people and animals! God's instructions to Noah were perfect; he, his family and all the animals on the ark were safe in the flood.
