Have some family fun this week!

Set out large toys or chairs across the room as obstacles. Explain to kids that they will take turns being led across the room by you. They will not be able to see, but you will make sure they do not step on or run into anything. Blindfold children one at a time and lead each child safely across the room. Children who do not wish to be blindfolded may simply close their eyes. **SAY:** You had to trust me to get across the room safely. Abraham trusted God when God asked him to give up his son.
